Kasim (27 years old) would like to retrain and work as a personal trainer



Kasim enrolls on the level 3 **Technical Occupational Entry qualification in Personal Training (Diploma)** and the **small Technical Specialist qualification in Optimising Training for the Ageing Client (Award)**
