## Preparing to deliver

The AoC (Association of Colleges) delivers preparatory support. This provides one-to-one support with planning a high-quality T Level offer for the two years in the lead up to delivering a T Level.

The offer includes opportunities for networking, mentoring and buddying and hearing from providers who have expertise in specific areas of T Level delivery.

## CPD training for teachers to upskill to deliver T Level qualifications

The Education and Training Foundation (ETF) have been contracted to provide free CPD training for teachers to prepare to teach T Levels via the **T Level Professional Development (TLPD) Programme**.

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# Support for the T Level Foundation Year

**These support materials will support you in delivering the T Level Foundation Year.**

The **T Level Foundation Year** (previously known as the T Level Transition Programme) is a one-year, level 2 study programme designed for learners aged 16 to 19 (and up to 24 for those with Education, Health and Care Plans) who aim to progress onto a T Level.

It provides a high-quality route onto T Levels for students who have the potential to succeed in T Levels but would benefit from the additional study time and preparation that it will give them before they start their T Level.

**Core focus:** The T Level Foundation Year builds learners' readiness for T Levels through learning of essential skills in English, maths, digital literacy, technical knowledge and professional behaviours.

#### Core Elements:

- English, maths & digital skills: strengthening learners academic and digital capabilities.
- Workplace experience: real or simulated work environments to build industry awareness.
- Personal development: activities to boost confidence, resilience, and self-esteem.
- Technical skills: introductory training aligned to the chosen T Level route.
- Pastoral support: promoting wellbeing through tailored care and guidance.
- Diagnostic start & monitoring: early assessment to personalise learning and track progress.
